

2016 TOWN OF CRESTED BUTTE COMMUNITY GRANT REQUEST CRITERIA

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS MAY 27, 2016

The Town of Crested Butte is now accepting requests for funding from the 2016 Community Grants spring program. Funding requests should be submitted to the Finance Director by May 27, 2016. Final decisions on funding will be finished by late June.

The Town of Crested Butte Community Grants program is designed to support projects and programs which meet the needs and desires of the residents and businesses within the Town limits. The general intent of this program is to fund services and programs not offered through the Town and to assist with start-up programs or services to help get them off the ground, but not to be dependent upon the Town.

APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS:

- Non-profit 501 organizations in good standing with the IRS, State of Colorado and the Town of Crested Butte or local, state and federal agencies.
- For-profit entities may apply through a local non-profit or governmental agency which will serve as the sponsor and administrative agency for managing the grant.
- Applicant must provide significant, measurable direct services to Town of Crested Butte residents or businesses.
- Applicant may not be controlled in whole or in part by a church or sectarian society. Factors considered in making a determination of whether a particular organization is controlled by a church or sectarian society include: the organization under which the tax exempt status is obtained, who administers the organization, and the level of funding from a church or sectarian society.
- Programs, activities, employment opportunities, and other operations of the applicant which may be funded totally or partially by the Town of Crested Butte must comply with local, state and national legal requirements related to non-discrimination and immigration and may not advocate or advance a particular political or religious viewpoint.
- Applicant may not use funding as a means to provide grant funding for other organizations.
- All funds awarded through the Community Grant program are to remain local and are not to be used to fund national organizations (i.e. dues, etc.).

APPLICATION CRITERIA:

All applications must include the following items:

1. Complete Community Grant Program Funding Application—form is available on the Town of Crested Butte's website at www.townofcrestedbutte.com
2. Overall organization budget
3. Budget specific to the project or event for which funding is being requested

Completed applications should be submitted to by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 27, 2016. The preferred method of delivery is via email to loisr@crestedbutte-co.gov.
