**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING BALLOT MEASURE 5A REAUTHORIZING THE  
GUNNISON VALLEY REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY**

**WHEREAS**, the Gunnison Valley Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) is a joint enterprise between the Town of Crested Butte, The Town of Mount Crested Butte, The City of Gunnison, and Gunnison County; and

**WHEREAS**, since its inception in January 2003, the RTA has effectively assured air service to the Gunnison Valley; and

**WHEREAS**, the RTA has greatly enhanced free bus service between Gunnison and Mount Crested Butte; and


**WHEREAS**, since November of 2007, the RTA busses have carried over 70,000 passengers, thus significantly reducing carbon emissions and private vehicle use; and

**WHEREAS**, 2008 ballot measure 5A will reauthorize RTA funding at current levels with no new tax increase;


