A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CRESTED BUTTE LOCAL LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY TO ISSUE SPECIAL EVENT LIQUOR PERMITS TO QUALIFIED ENTITIES WITHOUT PRIOR NOTIFICATION TO OR APPROVAL FROM THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 11-066 will take effect August 10, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 11-006 allows for local liquor licensing authorities to issue special event liquor permits to qualified entities without prior notification to or approval from the State licensing authority; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Crested Butte, Colorado is the local liquor licensing authority for the Town of Crested Butte, Colorado and desires to issue special event liquor permits without prior notification to or approval from the State licensing authority;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CRESTED BUTTE, COLORADO, THAT

1. The Town Council of the Town of Crested Butte, Colorado, in its capacity as the local licensing authority, hereby elects to issue special event liquor permits to qualified entities pursuant to Title 12, Article 48, Part 1, Colorado Revised Statutes, without prior notification to or approval from the State licensing authority.
2. Upon issuance of any special event liquor permit, the Town shall report to the Liquor Enforcement Division of the Department of Revenue within ten (10) days after issuance, the name of the organization to which a permit was issued, the address of the permitted location and the permitted dates of alcohol beverage service.
