Dear Building/Restaurant Owner:

This letter is to inform you that according to the Town of Crested Butte's pretreatment ordinance adopted on July 1, 2013, all food service establishments (FSE) are required to have a gravity grease interceptor (GGI) of a minimum size of 500 gallons installed by January 1, 2014. **All FSE must submit a completed Food Service Pretreatment Application.** The purpose of the pretreatment ordinance is to protect the waste water treatment works from fats, oils and grease (FOG) being discharged into the sanitary sewer.

A variance to this requirement may be granted by the Town of Crested Butte. If you wish to apply for a variance please submit a letter explaining why you are unable to install an interceptor and how you plan to reduce FOG discharge from your restaurant. Attach this letter to a completed Food Service Pretreatment Application form.

A sewer surcharge of \$10.55/EQR will be applied to the monthly sewer bill of all parties granted a variance. EQRs are assigned to restaurants based on the EQR table in the Town of Crested Butte Municipal code Sec. 13-1-170.

Food service pretreatment applications and requests for variance must be submitted for review by **November 1, 2013**. Application forms can be picked up at town hall or downloaded from the Town of Crested Butte Pretreatment website at www.cbpretreatment.com.
