A Resolution Supporting the Stabilization and Rehabilitation of the Historic Denver & Rio Grande Railroad Depot in Crested Butte

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Crested Butte recognizes the benefits and importance of historic preservation and the need to preserve the Denver & Rio Grande Railroad Depot; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council strongly supports the stabilization and rehabilitation of the Denver & Rio Grande Railroad Depot, hereinafter referred to as the "Project".

WHEREAS, the Town Council recognizes that the Denver & Rio Grande Depot contributes to the Town's goals of providing attractive public facilities, preserving the Town's heritage, providing affordable housing and supporting non-profit activities it is in the Town's interest to rehabilitate and make more energy efficient this important community asset.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CRESTED BUTTE, COLORADO THAT:

1. The Town Council of the Town of Crested Butte designates \$200,000 from the General Capital Fund as grant matching funds for the Project.
2. The Town Council of the Town of Crested Butte supports grant applications to the State Historical Fund of the Colorado Historical Society, the Colorado Department of Transportation, Transportation Enhancement Program Grant and others.
