





























passengers per day. In February of this year, ridership averaged 1,600 people per day, meaning on average the buses were 65% empty. It is important to note the buses did run at capacity during the 2023/24 winter on 38 runs, less than 3% of the time.

Lastly, Town has an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the school district allowing for public parking at the school when it is not being used for school-related activities, meaning the lot could function as a parking lot for the Town on weekends. The Town is working with our partners at Crested Butte Mountain Resort, the Town of MtCB, Mountain Express, and the RTA to create a transit solution for peak winter weekends & holidays.

**Recommendation:**

Based on additional feedback received, staff requests final direction from Council to execute the parking management contract with Interstate Parking for the 2024/25 winter season.
