



A PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER OF THE TOWN OF CRESTED BUTTE, COLORADO FOR THE PROMOTION OF HEALTH AND SUPPRESSION OF DISEASE EXTENDING THE REQUIREMENT FOR PEDESTRIANS TO WEAR FACE COVERINGS ON PORTIONS OF ELK AVENUE AND ITS SIDE STREETS IN THE TOWN OF CRESTED BUTTE AND WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT FOR BOZAR REVIEW OF APPLICATIONS TO ERECT TEMPORARY FABRIC STRUCTURES IN THE TOWN OF CRESTED BUTTE

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2020, the Town issued a Public Health Order requiring pedestrians to wear face coverings on portions of Elk Avenue and its side streets in the Town of Crested Butte; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the July 8, 2020 Order is attached hereto and the Recitals of such Order are incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the July 8, 2020 Public Health Order expires on September 30, 2020, unless it is renewed or extended; and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2020, the Town Council found that it is appropriate and in the interests of the public health, safety, and welfare and would further protect property and civil order, for the Town Manager to extend the July 8, 2020 Public Health Order; and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2020, the Town Council directed that the requirement for review and approval of permit applications to install Tent/Fabric Structures on private property by the Board of Zoning and Architectural Review (“BOZAR”) pursuant to Section 16-14-180 of the Town Code be temporarily waived in order to allow restaurants in the Town to continue to promote social distancing for their customers as the fall and winter seasons approach; and

WHEREAS, this Public Health Order is being issued to limit the continuing health impacts of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, this Public Health Order is intended to extend beyond and in no way diminish the requirements of the Tenth Amended Public Health Order issued by Gunnison County on June 8, 2020, and which remains in effect; and

WHEREAS, this Order is adopted pursuant to the legal authority set forth in C.R.S. Section 31-15-401(b), and Crested Butte Municipal Code Chapter 2, Section 9, as well as all other applicable laws, rules, regulations, orders, and declarations. Under this authority, the Town Manager of Crested Butte is empowered to “exercise emergency powers permitted by state and local law... [and] may promulgate regulations or issue orders as he or she deems necessary to protect life and property, preserve critical resources, or otherwise implement the Town’s Emergency Response Plan”; and


