

**ORDINANCE NO. 6**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CRESTED BUTTE TOWN  
COUNCIL AMENDING CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 4 TO  
MODIFY FOOD TRUCK REGULATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Crested Butte, Colorado (the "**Town**") is a home rule municipality duly and regularly organized and now validly existing as a body corporate and politic under and by virtue of the Constitution and the laws of the State of Colorado; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article XX, Section 6 of the Colorado Constitution, as implemented through the Town of Crested Butte Charter, the Town has the authority to enact and enforce regulations regulating food trucks within the Town's jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 6-4-80(1), of the Crested Butte Municipal Code (the "Code") states that late-night food truck vendors may only operate in the "B-1" Business Zone District; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 6-4-80(2), of the Crested Butte Municipal Code (the "Code") states that late-night food truck vendors may only operate between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 2:30 a.m.; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 6-4-80(1-10), and Section 6-4-10 of the Crested Butte Municipal Code (the "Code") refer to the term late-night food truck; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 6-4-10 defines late-night food truck as a licensed motor vehicle no greater than eight (8) feet wide by twenty (20) feet long that is mobile and used for vending food; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that the below amendments are in the best interests of the health, safety, and general welfare of the Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CRESTED BUTTE, COLORADO, THAT,**

**1. Amending Chapter 6, Article 4, Section 10**

Repealing and replacing the definition of late-night food truck. The definition of food truck in Section 6-4-10 should read as follows: "Food truck means a licensed vehicle or licensed vehicles that aggregately do not exceed the maximum size of eight (8) feet wide by twenty (20) feet long that are mobile and used for vending food."

**2. Amending Chapter 6, Article 4, Section 80**

**Section 6-4-80(1)**, shall be amended to read as follows:

"Four total parking spots in the Four Way parking lot will be designated for two food trucks. The designated parking spots will be on the south side of the parking lot and specifically

assigned by the Town Manager at the time of license issuance. Food truck vendors may operate from public parking spaces in the “B-1” Business Zone District during designated hours.”

**Section 6-4-80(2)**, shall be amended to read as follows:

“Food truck vendors may operate between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. in the designated parking spots in the Four Way parking lot and between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 2:30 a.m. in public parking spaces in the “B-1” Business Zone District.”

**Section 6-4-80(1-10) and Section 6-4-10** shall be amended to repeal the term, “late-night”, from food truck.

**Section 6-4-80(11)**, shall be added to read as follows: “Town of Crested Butte will not provide power in the form of electricity or otherwise nor will the Town of Crested Butte provide sewer/water or any other utilities for any food truck operations. A generator supplied by the vendor itself may be used but only in compliance with Town Code Section 10-9-60.”

**Section 6-4-80(12)**, shall be added to read as follows: “If a food truck vendor license is not utilized at least once in any four-week period the license may be revoked by the Town.”


