AN ORDINANCE OF THE CRESTED BUTTE TOWN COUNCIL
REPEALING PART IV OF APPENDIX N OF THE CRESTED BUTTE
MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Crested Butte, Colorado ("the Town") is a home rule municipality duly and regularly organized and now validly existing as a body corporate and public under and by virtue of the Colorado Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, Part IV of Appendix N of the Crested Butte Municipal Code addresses employee rental guidelines that would be more appropriately addressed by a policy of the Town rather than as a part of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Town Council finds it is necessary and proper to repeal Part IV of Appendix N of the Crested Butte Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CRESTED BUTTE COLORADO:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

Section 2. Part IV of Appendix N of the Crested Butte Municipal Code is hereby repealed.


Section 3. The codifier is hereby authorized to renumber the Code in conformance with this amendment.
