

# PAVILIONS

## No GLASS or DOGS allowed in any Parks with Pavilions

1. Take care of all facilities and pick up all trash after the event.
2. No motor vehicles are allowed inside the pavilions or on any driveways leading to the pavilions.
3. Use only the grills provided inside the Pavilions for all-private grilling. Contracted concessionaires must keep their operations off all grass areas and may only set-up on the gravel, or pavement. Leave coals in grill.
4. Trash cans and recycling bins are provided for your convenience. Trash cans must be securely closed (bear-proofed) and recycling bins un-contaminated. Recycling bins accept #1 and #2 plastics, tin, and aluminum.
5. Picnic tables should be placed under the pavilion cover in a user friendly fashion after the event.
6. Under no conditions will tents larger than 10 ft x 12 ft be permitted.
7. "Pop-Up" Tents smaller than 10 ft x 12 ft are allowed on the grass area surrounding the Pavilion. Tent use requires permission from the Parks & Recreation Office and **no stakes** may be used. Cinderblocks and plastic gallon milk jugs filled with either water or sand work well to secure tents.
8. Do not empty ice chests on the grass; it freezes and kills the grass.
9. A light switch and electrical sockets are located in the pavilion, please turn the lights off after use.
10. Alcohol consumption shall be in accordance with the liquor code of Colorado.
11. If there will be amplified sound during your event then the rules and requirements of Crested Butte Municipal Code Section 10-9-50 must be followed. In addition, rules specific to pavilion use prohibit amplified sound past 8:00 p.m.
12. Pavilion users must understand that other events may be operating in the area during the reserved time. The surrounding areas are public parks that provide facilities for, but are not limited to, outdoor music concerts, baseball, softball, soccer, rock climbing, playground use and **community recreation**.
13. Reservations are not final until a contract is signed; applicable payments, including deposits, are made; and necessary documents returned to the Parks and Recreation Department.
14. If there is something wrong, broken, unkempt, or needed, please contact the Recreation Office at 349-7197.

These rules must be respected and followed in order for your deposit to be returned.
