A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF RUBBER-TRACKED SNOW CAT MACHINES, THE RESTRICTIONS OF OPERATIONS AND THE DESIGNATED ROUTE

WHEREAS, Section 8-1-30(4)(16) of the Crested Butte Municipal Code allows the Town to grant permission by permit for the use of rubber-tracked snow cat machines; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-1-30(4)(16) of the Crested Butte Municipal Code requires that the Town Manager annually designate a limited access snow cat route for the use of rubber-tracked snow cat machines on Town streets; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-1-30(4)(16) of the Crested Butte Municipal Code requires that the Town Council approve the continued operation of rubber-tracked snow cat machines, the designated route and the restrictions of operation by formal resolution following a public hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CRESTED BUTTE, COLORADO as follows:

1. The Town Council approves the continued operation of rubber-tracked snow cat machines in accordance with the provisions of Section 8-1-30(4)(16) of the Crested Butte Municipal Code.
2. The designated route for the operation of rubber-tracked snow cat machines is as follows:
 - (a) Whiterock Avenue between Kebler Pass Road and the middle of the 500 Block between 5th and 6th Streets.
 - (b) Belleview Avenue between 4th and 5th Streets.
 - (c) 4th and 5th Streets between Whiterock Avenue and Belleview Avenue.
 - (d) 2nd Street north of Whiterock Avenue to 512 2nd Street.


